

LOLA SCARF



WHAT YOU WILL NEED TO KNIT THIS SCARF:

4mm (US6) 80cm circular needle

4mm (US6) straight needles

3mm (US3) crochet

Stitch markers

Row counter

GAUGE :

For a 10cmx10cm sample in stockinette stitch with 4mm (US6) needle, you should have 24sts and 32r.

The pattern is written for one size only.

Yarn: approx 5 balls of Lang's "Baby Alpaga" (50g/169m)

Before you start, leave aside approx 30 metres of yarn that will serve for the fringes.

CO 86sts with 4mm (US6) circular needle using the provisional cast on method (these sts will be bound off right at the end)

Place two s/m. One that will stay on the CO r, and one that will serve for the knitting.

Cont in the round as follows:

1st SERIE: p 30r

2nd SERIE: from s/m: *p21, k1tbl, p42, k1tbl, p to end. Repeat * for 10r.

3rd SERIE: from s/m: *p14, k1tbl, (p6, k1tbl) x2, p28, k1tbl, (p6, k1tbl) x2, p to end.
Repeat * for 10r.

4th SERIE: from s/m: *p7, k1tbl, (p6, k1tbl) x4, p14, k1tbl, (p6, k1tbl) x6, p to end.

Cont straight for 1 metre (or desired length), and make again 3rd SERIE, 2nd SERIE, and 1st SERIE.

Place s/m 43sts from the start one. BO both layers together (43sts each) on 3 needles, thus closing that end of the tube.

Using the s/m that stayed on the CO r, place the provisional CO sts on two separate needles (43 each) distributed as above, and BO both layers together on 3 needles.

FRINGES:

1 fringe = an approx 1,2m piece of yarn folded into 8 = approx 15cm fringe
With 3mm (US3) crochet, place 11 fringes on each extremity.
Cut open the closed loops and do a final trim.

FINISHING:

Steam iron making sure the twisted sts on each side overlap each other.
